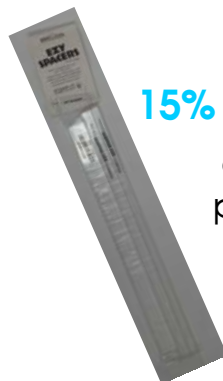

Do you have a card making or scrapbooking group, and are looking for somewhere for your group to meet?

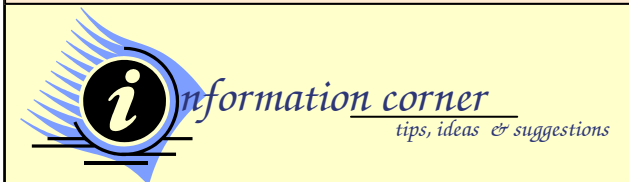

Do you want to do more scrapbooking, but are put off by the cost of buying embellishments? Then this class is for you. You will get to learn how to use your tools and products to create your own embellishments. This includes punching, stamping, glitter, opals, kindly glitz, you also create your own patterned 'stamp pad'. The Cricut and Gypsy are also put to use for this double page layout, along with the Curvy cutter.



When scrapbooking and you need to a page heading but don't want to purchase stickers etc., why not make your own - even if you don't have a die cutting machine. Do you have some letter stamps, if the lettering are big enough, stamp the letters you require onto card, emboss them if you want, then just cut around them. They can then be applied to the page, either flat onto the page or with 3D mounting foam to give
